Quarterly report to HAUC(UK)

The committee is undergoing major changes with personnel changes on both sides. Steve Barriff has stood down as Highways Side Chair, prior to his impending, and well-earned, retirement. Barry Lucas, previously Highways Side Secretary, has taken his place with Louise Nagle, currently the Streetworks Manager at Hammersmith and Fulham, replacing him.

On the Utilities side, Guy Townsend has left Global Crossing and is now plying his trade elsewhere. His place as Utilities Side Secretary is likely to be taken by Martin Zelder from National Grid Gas.

London HAUC released five guidance notes after its' February meeting. Aimed at allaying concerns about recycled materials the notes cover testing procedures, use of the Cone Penetrometer, ARMS, recycled crushed materials and coring regimes.

The working party will reconvene to discuss submissions from the area groups for the development of further guidance notes in due course.

On 2nd April London HAUC held its' third annual Expo at the Old Brewery in Chiswell Street. There were 40 exhibitors, 12 presentations, and nearly 600 registrants and over 600 attendees. Initial feedback has been positive and the committee will soon be examining the data from the returns to ascertain what form the event should take in future.
