#### **Citation**

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Traffic Management Act 2004 (Commencement No.2) (England) Order 2004.

#### **Commencement of provisions**

**2.** The following provisions of the Traffic Management Act 2004 shall come into force as respects England on 4th January 2005:

(a) Part 2; and

(b) section 43(1), (2) and (4).
